## PET PREP STEPS BEFORE THE TRIP



Research pet-friendly campsites or other accommodations for your stay.



Go over campground rules and any pet policies for each destination.



Visit the vet for a checkup and get up to date on flea and tick control.



Microchip your pet if you haven't already and update ID tags with current contact info.



Create a list of pet necessities and purchase missing equipment.



## PACK THE ESSENTIALS

- Pet food and bowl
- Water bowl
- Collar with ID tags
- Leash and harness
- Treats
- Toys
- Medications
- Brush and cleaning supplies
- Bedding
- Carrier, crate or kennel
- Litter box
- Waste pickup bags

## PET SAFETY & EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS



- Designate a comfy spot in the vehicle with a seat belt harness or secured carrier.
- Put together a first-aid kit with pet-safe products in case of injury.
- Bring proof of ownership, veterinary records and a current photo.
- Have emergency contact information for a vet nearby.
- Be prepared for encounters with wildlife.
- Pay close attention to any signs of heat exhaustion, poisoning and dehydration.



## RV TRAVELING WITH YOUR PET

- Ensure the RV is equipped with everything your pet needs such as no-spill dishes, washing supplies or a pet ramp.
- Plan pet-friendly activities like leisure walks, hikes or visits to a dog-safe beach.
- Do not leave your pet unattended during the trip.
- Protect your dog's paws during exercise and outdoor activities.
- Respect other visitors by leashing/controlling your pet.
- Watch out for wildlife and other potential dangers.
- Abide by all campground rules and regulations.
- Make sure your pet is adequately hydrated.
- Clean up after your pet.
